QUESTION OF: Addressing the Haitian President hostage crisis

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL,

*Deeply concerned* that the terrorists in Haitian are harming civilians economically, physically, emotionally, and physiologically,

*Bearing in mind* that Haitian has just experienced a severe earthquake and several aftershocks a few weeks ago and is an enormous fiscal deficit,

*Alarmed by the* earthquakes, aftershocks, and the terrorist attacks, which caused an unstable economy in Haiti,

*Recognizing* that amid gang violence, food shortages, lack of education and shelter, Haiti continues to be at an increasing risk of natural disaster,

*Aware* of the fact that the Haitian National Government has repeatedly postponed national elections and that many citizens have shown disapproval of recent actions:

1. Encourages all nations to send supporters to fly to Haiti and save the president from the terrorists through ways such as but not limited to:

a. Sending trained Police to the rescue including organizations including but not limited to:

- i. FBI,
- ii. CIA,
- iii. World Rescue Organization (WRO)

b. Sending Avengers to rescue the president of Haiti including but not limited to:

- i. Iron man,
- ii. Captain America,
- iii. Thor,

- iv. Spider man,
- v. Black Panther,
- vi. Thanos,

2. Urges members from all nations to donate money to Haiti through ways such as but not limited to:

a. Donate money to Haiti through social media through ways such as but not limited to:

- i. WeChat Pay,
- ii. Alipay,
- iii. YouTube,
- iv. Twitter,
- v. Facebook,

3. Requests for the UN to burn down Haiti safely in ways including but not limited to,

a. ensure civilians safety and provide evacuated civilians with basic needs:

- i. Evacuating civilians in ways such as emergency routes, planes, and boats, into neighbouring countries,
- ii. Food,
- iii. Water,
- iv. Temporary Shelter,
- v. First aid kits/Medicine,

b. Making sure only terrorists are in Haiti when it burns down in ways including but not limited to:

- i. Bait, such as money,

c. Making sure the fire is contained in ways including but not limited to:

- i. Making sure the neighbouring countries are aware of the burning of Haiti,
- ii. Burning the outside first, to trap to terrorists, then let the flames spread;

4. Calls upon the UN to educate the terrorists in ways including but not limited to,

a. Inventing a time travelling machine and going back in time to educate the future terrorists and encourage them to lead a normal, good life such as but not limited to:
